

DACULA JUNIOR FALCONS PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Initial	As PARENT/GUARDIAN, I WILL (please initial next to each item):
/	Be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other event.
/	Not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
/	_ Remain in the spectator areas during all games unless you are on the working team.
/	_ Respect the officials and their authority during games.
/	_ Never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the tournament event, or just before or after a practice, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
/	_ Refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices.
/	_ Encourage my child to discuss issues with the coach.
/	_ Show my support for the entire team and not just my child.
/	_ Never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake.
/	Teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or her performance.
/	Demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
/	_ Inform the coach of any conflicts with practices and tournaments well in advance of the event, so that the coach can adequately prepare, make adjustments, etc.
/	_ Inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child, in advance.
/	_ Not "bad mouth" or speak negatively about coaches, players, parents or the team to others in or out of DJF.
/	_ Ensure that relatives & guests abide by the DJF Parent's Code of Conduct.
/	Agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:
	Verbal warning by official, head coach, tournament director, and/or DJF Advisory Board.
	Parental game/match/tournament suspension with written documentation of incident kept
	on file by organizations involved.
	Parental season suspension
